



Govins Point releases will divert to spillway beginning March 26
3/25/2014
Due to maintenance and repairs at the Govins Point Dam power plant, water releases, which normally run through the powerhouse, will be diverted to the spillway beginning Wednesday, March 26. "We are releasing the same amount of water that we normally would. The difference is, it will be more visible to the public because we will be using the spillway instead of the powerhouse," said Dave Becker, Operations Project Manager for Govins Point.

Draft feasibility report for stream bank restoration near Werner, Neb. available for review
3/12/2014
A draft feasibility report and environmental assessment (EA) for stream bank restoration southwest of Werner, Neb. is currently available for public review. The report identifies alternatives to provide stream bank protection and prohibit further rapid erosion on the right-descending bank of the Elkhorn River, Cuming County, Neb. Public infrastructure being protected includes the Cuming County Road E bridge and roadway.

Omaha District Readiness Branch providing assistance in Montana and Wyoming
3/10/2014
Warmer temperatures are leading to flooding in parts of Wyoming and Montana along the Elghorn River, Little Elghorn River, Pryor Creek and tributaries of the Yellowstone River. In response to requests from the Crow Nation for sandbags, the State of Montana for ice jam technical assistance on the Mussellshell River, and from the State of Wyoming for technical assistance regarding an ice jam and flooding in north-central Wyoming along the Elghorn River, the Omaha District Readiness Branch has activated its Emergency Operations Center to Level III, Emergency Watch Status and is communicating directly with the National Weather Service for updated river stage forecasts.

While snowmelt and ice jam flooding can occur at any time, they typically occur during early spring thaw. Any ice jam can cause flooding or rapid increases in water levels within a short time period. Residents living near these rivers are reminded to monitor reports closely for ice jam flooding and be prepared to relocate to higher ground if flooding occurs. The levees in Greybull, Wyo., reduced risks to the town during recent ice jam flooding.

- Balancing Workforce and Workload Across the Corps




