## **November Meeting: Emergency Preparedness at Two Rivers Levee and Drainage Association**

The Two Rivers Levee and Drainage Association includes 3 levee protection systems consisting of 48,000 acres of protected area, 21 miles of levee, 4 pump stations, and several miles of interior drainage structures and ditches. During the 2008 flood, the north levee overtopped along the Iowa River, flooding 22,500 acres including the town of Oakville, Iowa. The lower 2 cells sustained water over the original levee height but due to flood fighting activities were able to withstand the flood of record. Ms Vicki Stoller, Administrator for the Two Rivers Levee and Drainage Association, will discuss how they prepare for flood events, respond to flood events, and recover. Flood recovery activities are still on-going. To date, the cost of the recovery has approached \$34 million dollars. Ms Stoller will explain her needs and difficulties during the process.


## **Other News**
