## March Meeting

### From “One Size Fits All” to “Risk Based Security”

This presentation, by Jeff Hardacre, will discuss various aspects relating to airport security and how it effects travelers. It will address questions including: “How has airport security changed in recent years?, How does this impact you as a frequent traveler?, and How will technology continue to impact airline travel?”

Jeff Hardacre is the Assistant Federal Security Director for the TSA’s Downstate Illinois 10 airports. Jeff joined TSA in 2002 as a Training Coordinator and was promoted to Management Analyst in 2003 before becoming the Assistant Federal Security Director for Screening in 2004, then Customer Support and Quality Improvement Manager in 2012, before moving into his current position in 2014.

Jeff graduated from the University of Dubuque with a B.S. in Aviation Administration and Business Administration in 1978. Jeff was hired by Mississippi Valley Airlines in 1977 and promoted to Station Manager in 1979. When MVA merged with Air Wisconsin (doing business as United Express), Jeff worked in a variety of management positions both in the headquarters and field environment for a total of 25 years before joining TSA.
