Engineering Ethics in Practice

This presentation will focus on engineering ethics in the engineering workplace. How engineering ethics are addressed by professional engineering societies; legal implications for professional engineers in Illinois and Iowa; ethical roles in the day to day work and tasks of engineers; contrast of engineering ethics to a few other professions. Participants will work through a few examples of common dilemmas in practice.


