In-Stream Construction & Bank Protection: Lessons Learned

Christopher B. Burke Engineering, Ltd. (CBBEL) has designed and managed construction of miles of stream stabilization and restoration projects. Over the years CBBEL has learned a number of valuable lessons from both a design and construction standpoint. This presentation is intended to relate those lessons to further the expertise of practitioners.

Jedd Anderson, PWS, CPESC, CWS, DECI is Vice President of CBBEL and Head of Environmental Resources Department, and has more than 26 years of experience covering more than 6,000 Environmental Resource projects. Jedd has been responsible for obtaining more than 1,500 USACE Section 404 permits; most notably, the O'Hare Airport expansion and the new Elgin O'Hare Western Access Tollway. He has years of practice in the design, permitting, mitigation and monitoring of projects and their impact on wetland and natural areas. Jedd's responsibilities include the day-to-day coordination of 16 environmental professionals, coordination and completion of Environmental Impact Statements, wetland and natural area assessments, delineations, design, permitting, maintenance and monitoring. Notably Jedd has designed two wetland restoration areas with a combined acreage of 700 acres and a \$19 million dollar budget. Additionally, Jedd has designed more than 10 miles of stream restoration/re-meandering projects.
